End date of Continuing Resolution



Maintains Budget Control Act caps

- 1. Prevents a government shutdown
- 2. Maintains funding at the current budget cap level
- 3. Includes provisions to continue essential government operations, including national defense

## **Bill Highlights**

- Includes additional Overseas Contingency Operations funds, including \$5.8B for the Department of Defense and \$4.3B for the State Department, to support military efforts to fight ISIS and terror around the globe and ensure the readiness of our troops
  - → Including increases in base discretionary spending, **Defense funding level is \$8B** higher than the current Continuing Resolution
- Ensures the timely, cost-effective delivery of critical Defense equipment and systems:
  - Ohio Replacement Submarine
    Black Hawk Helicopter
- - Apache Attack Helicopter
- KC-46A Tanker
- Maintains the strong protection of our homeland by updating funding for Department of Homeland Security operations, ensuring DHS can continue border security, immigration enforcement, aviation security, and protection of the President-elect
- Continues the freeze on Member pay that has been in effect since 2010. Without this change, a cost-of-living adjustment would go into effect in January
- Provides needed funding to respond to devastation and damage caused by recent natural disasters, including Hurricane Matthew, floods, and drought, including
  - \$1.025B to repair damaged Corps of Engineers projects
  - \$1B for emergency relief through the Federal Highway Administration
  - \$1.8B for Community Development Block Grants
  - \$206M for critical Department of Agriculture watershed protection programs
  - \$74.7M to repair damaged NASA facilities
- Supports the 21st Century Cures Act, by including funding for FDA and NIH innovation, as well as \$500M to continue state response to the opioid crisis. This funding is fully offset
- Allows \$170M for health and drinking water infrastructure investments. This funding is fully offset
